OVERALL RULES:

- The general rules and regulations of the Jefferson County Fair apply.
- Open to JEFFERSON COUNTY Residents only.
- ENTRY DATE IS MONDAY, AUGUST 6TH ONLY, FROM NOON TO 8 PM.
- Entries will be hung on Tuesday, August 7, and judging will take place on Wednesday, August 8. No one will be admitted on those days.
- All exhibits must remain in place until 6PM Sunday, August 12, and should be claimed between 6PM and 7PM Sunday or on Monday, August 13 between 9 AM and 11AM.
- LIABILITY: Every precaution will be taken to prevent loss or damage to entries, but the **artist/photographer assumes all responsibility in case of loss, theft, or vandalism.** In no case will the management of the Jefferson County Fair or the Department Superintendent be responsible for loss or damage.
- Work previously shown in the Jefferson County Fair is not eligible. All work must have been completed in the last two years.
- The Fair Board reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any entry of questionable subject matter.
- Each entry will be categorized by lot (age) as follows:
 - Lot 1. Senior - 70 and over
 - Lot 2. Adult – 18-69
 - Lot 3. Teen – 14-17
 - Lot 4. Intermediate – 8-13
 - Lot 5. Child – 7 and under

ENTRY INFORMATION:

When: Monday, August 6 – 12 noon to 8pm
How: Submit completed entry form to Fair Office and then take the entries to Art Building.
Additional Assistance: an Exhibitor 101 class for those interested will be presented at the Fair

FINE ARTS ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Entry Limits – an individual can submit up to four (4) Fine Arts entries.
- Acceptable Sizes – any two dimensional entry (i.e. paintings/drawings) can not exceed 48 inches, including the frame, in its longest measurement (exceptions may be made only if suitable space is available) sculpture/three dimensional entries must be of a reasonable size and weight for appropriate showing, the Department Superintendent has the authority to reject items for which there is not sufficient space.
- Framing/Hanging/Display – entries must be ready for display – please observe the following:
 - Framed entries must have metallic screw eyes and braided wire for hanging – entries with string, adhesive tape, saw-tooth or stick on hangers are not allowed.
 - Matted work that is unframed should not have any glass and must be on rigid mat board or foam core backing and have self-adhesive plastic hang tabs for hanging.
 - All freestanding entries, such as sculptures, must be stable for display on a shelf.
 - Child age Lot entries are encouraged to meet the above hanging and presentation expectations but not required to do so.

PHOTOGRAPHY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Entry Limits – an individual can submit up to (4) Photography entries.
- Acceptable sizes – Photography entries (including matting) should be no smaller than 8” x 10” and no larger than 16” x 20”.
- Framing/Mounting – framed photograph entries must have metallic screw eyes and braided wire for hanging – entries with string, adhesive tape saw-tooth or stick-on hangers are not allowed. Matted work that is unframed should not have any glass and must be on rigid mat board or foam core backing and have self-adhesive plastic hang tabs for hanging.

- **Hanging** – photographs on rigid mat board cardboard/foam core backing must have self-adhesive plastic hang tabs, framed photography entries must have metallic screw eyes and braided wire for hanging.

JUDGING AND AWARDS

General Awards – The DANISH SYSTEM is used (entries are evaluated on their own merit and not evaluated against other like entries) and all Senior, Adult, Teen and Intermediate age lots will receive a Blue or Red ribbon/award. Child entries will receive an exhibition ribbon, which will not qualify for a monetary award.

- **Class C – Cartoons:** Teen and Intermediate only. Cartoons
- **Class D – Sculpture:** 3 dimensional original art – Clay, Wood, Metal, Blown or Stained Glass and Mixed media.
- **Class E – Printmaking:** Woodcuts, Etchings, Intaglio, Lithographs, Silk-screened art, etc.
- **Class F – Computer Art:** images which have been generated by a computer operated by the submitting artist.
